

Arizona Counseling & Treatment Services Human Services Scholarship Application

Qualifications

- Nominee must be a sanctioned USBC bowler
- Nominee must be a high school junior or graduating senior, currently attending a public university, private university, junior college, state college, technical school or trade school pursuing a human services type degree.

Scholarship

1. The scholarship will range in the amount of \$250.00 to \$1,000.00 (based on funds available) to be paid to the school of choice. Funds may be used according to SMART regulations.
2. Your scholarship funds are available for six years from the date of your high school graduation, or if you already have graduated from high school, from the date you won the scholarship. The one exception would be if a recipient would enlist in the military, the expiration date is extended by the number of years of the first enlistment period only, i.e.: two-year enlistment, expiration date would be extended by two years.
3. If the recipient leaves school permanently, SMART will continue to manage the funds for individuals with issued scholarships. Any unassigned or expiring funds will be transferred to the USBC general scholarship fund.
4. Two years and one year prior to the expiration date, you will receive letters reminding you of your scholarship's expiration date. Your scholarship funds are not transferable; only the original recipient may use the funds.

Procedures

- Nominee must submit a completed application
- Nominee must write an essay to include information on one or more of the following subjects. This essay should be written in three hundred words or less.
 1. Why you would like to receive the award.
 2. How it would help you to continue your education.
 3. What you plan to do after obtaining your degree.
 4. Aspects of your community and civic activities.

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Guidelines for scholarship eligibility and selection

1. ACTS scholarships are open to any USBC sanctioned bowler.
 2. Applicant must have amateur status in all athletics.
 3. Applicant can use the scholarship monies at any institute of post-secondary education. This includes technical or trade schools as well as two and four year colleges.
 4. Applicant must enroll or be enrolled for the fall semester following graduation or be a continuing collegiate or technical or trade school student.
 5. This scholarship award will be in the amount of \$250 to \$1,000 (based on funds). The scholarship will be paid via SMART.
 6. Your scholarship funds are available for six years from the date of your high school graduation, or if you already have graduated from high school, from the date you won the scholarship. The one exception would be if a recipient would enlist in the military, the expiration date is extended by the number of years of the first enlistment period only, i.e.: two-year enlistment, expiration date would be extended by two years.
 7. Your scholarship funds are approved for the following: tuition fees, textbooks, meal plans, housing plans and required class supplies and equipment necessary for the successful completion of a course or program at universities, colleges, business schools, technical schools, trade schools, vocational schools and continuing educational courses. The funds, after final review and approval, only will be paid directly to the institution.
 8. Recipient of the award will be notified by Arizona Counseling & Treatment Services by July 15th of each year. If circumstances allow, the recipient will be invited to an Arizona Counseling & Treatment Services meeting to be presented the award.
 9. Application filing deadline is June 30th of each year.
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Selection Rules

Selection of recipient will be based on bowling involvement, academic standing, leadership qualities, community involvement, and essays submitted.

Applicants will be rated as follows:

™ Academic standing	1-35points
(Class rank.....15 points)	
(GPA.....20 points)	
™ Communication skill/essay	1-20 points
™ Bowling involvement	1-25 points
™ Community/Civic involvement	1-20 points

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Instructions to Applicant

1. Complete Section 1 yourself. Fill in the form completely. Incomplete forms will not be considered.
2. Give appropriate Section 2 to your USBC League Secretary or USBC Certified Coach for their evaluation (if applicable). Additional copies of this section may be made if you bowl in more than one league.
3. Give Section 3 to your Academic Counselor/Advisor (if applicable).
