5th Annual Yuma USBC Senior Women's Championship Tournament

- 1. The Yuma USBC Annual Championship Tournaments purpose is to determine the scratch champions for Doubles, Singles and All Events in each division. A plaque and USBC chevrons will be awarded to the highest actual pinfall in each division in each event. In case of a tie, co-champions will be declared, and duplicate awards will be given. Cash prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis for each event per division, except for All Events. Prize ratio shall be at least one in seven. For dbls,sgls
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: Tournament open to all female USBC certified bowlers who are members of the Yuma USBC association and are 50 years of age as of January 29th 2011.
- **3. AVERAGES:** Qualifying averages, in order of acceptability, shall be:
 - a. Highest 2009-10 book average of 21 or more games.
 - b. Highest current average of 15 or more games in the same league as of December 1, 2010 with written verification from the league secretary.
 - c. If none of the above, bowler will be assigned an average of 200.
 - d. No professional bowlers allowed.
 - e. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of there average (see USBC Rule 319(a))
 - f. USBC Rules 319a(2), 319d, and 319e will not apply to this tournament.
- **4. Multiple Participation:** Bowlers may enter doubles twice, however, participants may not bowl with the same partner twice. Participants may only bowl singles and all events once. A competitors initial participation in the doubles/singles event, requires them to bowl both doubles and singles. A participant bowling a multiple doubles session will only pay and bowl for the doubles portion after the initial competition.
- 5. When a bowler participates more than once in doubles, the first appearance in each shall count towards scratch and handicap all events. All events includes the six game total while bowling during the 1st appearance in doubles and singles.
- 6. ALL EVENTS IS OPTIONAL AND WILL BE BOWLED ON A SCRATCH BASIS. Any entrant not paying the optional all events fee shall not be eligible for *cash prizes* in that event. Separate Prize Fund to be distributed in each division. The bowler who places first in each division in All Events shall be entitled to an award regardless of whether they had paid the optional prize fee. The Overall All Events winner shall be given a special award by Yuma USBC. They are not entitled to any portion of the optional All Events prize fund unless they had paid the optional fee. All Events prize ratio shall be at least one in five.
 - a. Paid All Events are not transferable unless the substitute replaces the original entrant in all both events and the transfer is made by the tournament director or their assistants prior to time of the substitute's participation in any event.
- 7. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between the entrant's average and 200 for singles, 400 for doubles.
- 8. Substitutes: Subs are allowed. The tournament director must be advised of all subs at least one hour before the scheduled bowling time, if possible. In case of an emergency, after a game has started, a sub, if one is available shall be allowed in doubles only. If no sub is available, only the actual number of frames bowled shall count. A sub, when replacing another bowler, must bowl the doubles/singles for the same bowler in order to qualify for all events, provided the all events is paid. A sub shall not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee or prize money won.
- 9. Any player or doubles team arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. If an entrant is late for the doubles event, the entrant present shall bowl there singles first. If the partner has not arrived by the time the singles event is finished and a substitute cannot be found, the entrant present shall be permitted to bowl there games in the doubles event in order to qualify for the All Events championship.
- 10. Any check, in payment for entry fees for this tournament, that is returned for non-payment will be assessed a service charge of \$20.00.
- 11. DRESS CODE RULE: Entrants are expected to wear appropriate attire. Examples include slacks, neat jeans (no holes and not frayed), Capri pants, proper length* skirts, skorts, or dress shorts (NO JEAN SHORTS). Prohibited attire includes, but is not limited to: headgear (allowed for medical reasons only), tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, low-cut necklines, etc., shirts with inappropriate or vulgar pictures or writing, bib overalls, jeans not neat, clean, or in good condition, workout attire, short shorts*, short skorts*, and short skirts*. *NOTE: Skirt, skort, and short hemlines must extend beyond bowler's fingertips when standing relaxed and arms are extended downward at the bowler's side. Failure to comply, bowler will not be allowed to bowl and cause for forfeiture of entry fees. Tournament director or designee's decision as to appropriateness of attire will be final.
- 12. The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329. **PROTESTS MUST BE FILED IN WRITING WITHIN 24 HOURS**. After the tournament rules have been adopted, they may be changed prior to the start of the tournament by a two-thirds vote of the board of directors. The adopted rules must not conflict with USBC rules.
- 13. If not specifically stated in these local association tournament rules, USBC tournament rules shall apply.
