Bowlers may accumulate BOY points each league session. A bowler may not receive points for the same category more than once per week. For example: A person bowls two nights a week and bowls a 725 series and a 705 series in each league. The bowler would only be given 7 points for that week in the 700-749 series category. A person may accumulate as many points during a single league night as long as no duplicate categories are used. For example: Game one is 25 POA, game 2 is 50 POA, Game 3 is clean game & Dutch 200, is 75 POA series. Bowler had a 700 series. Points earned for the night (1,2,1,1,3,7, total 15 points. The Yuma USBC Awards Committee is responsible for awarding the points for each individual and determining the Association Bowler of the Year for the eight categories as described in the Yuma USBC Association Awards Program 2015-16.
