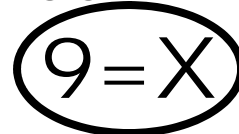


Yuma Youth Thanksgiving No-tap Turkey-shoot Tournament

Tournament Rules:

1. Tournament is open to all youth bowlers under the age of 20.
2. Handicap will be 90% of 180.
3. Bowlers will use their current 2011/12 league average. If no current league average, their 2011 summer league average will be used, otherwise 2010/11 average, if no average, then a scratch average will be used.
4. Prizes will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 5 of the final entries in each division. There will be a boys and girls sub-division for each division.

Individual's age as of August 1, 2011, will determine age classification. The tournament manager will have the authority to combine divisions based on the amount of entries & will be decided and announced prior to the competition.

5. **This is a fun tournament. This No-tap tournament is not sanctioned but USBC rules do apply. Strikes are given when a 9 count is rolled on the first ball.**

Yuma Youth Thanksgiving Turkey-Shoot No-tap Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Divisions and rules for our tournament are stated and included.
2. Separate events will be held for both boys and girls in all age divisions.
3. Age divisions:
 - a. *Peewee: Minimum age is 3. Maximum age is 7.*
 - b. *Bantams: 8-11 years of age.*
 - c. *Juniors: 12-15 years of age.*
 - d. *Majors/Seniors: 16-20 years of age.*
4. The tournament manager will have the authority to combine divisions based on the amount of entries & will be decided prior to the competition.
5. Individual's age as of August 1, 2011, will determine age classification.
6. All participants must bowl in their own age division.
7. Bumper bowler's scores will be based on three games, bumpers are a separate sub-division within the PeeWee Division during this tournament.
8. All other participants must bowl three games to qualify for an award.
9. Average rule: Bowlers will use their current 2011/12 league average. If no current league average, their 2011 summer league average will be used, otherwise 2010/11 average, Bowlers with no average, or league sessions, will be classified as scratch bowlers.
10. Peewee Division: The child must be able to pick up the bowling ball off of the rack and carry the ball to the foul line. The child can roll the ball with two hands, with or without bumpers. No parental or adult assistance is allowed in carrying the ball to the foul line. Please follow this rule.
11. Bumper bowlers will follow all of the above guidelines.
12. Check-in starts 45 minutes before scheduled bowling time.
13. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the playing area.
14. Coaching and refreshments are not allowed in the SETTEE area.
15. Each game must be bowled on a pair of lanes.
16. Foul lights must be in operation.
17. Awards will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 5 of the final entries in each division. Scholarship Prizes will be distributed using SMART Account 11193.
18. Bowlers knocking down nine pins on the first ball are awarded a strike.
19. Tournament is not sanctioned but, All USBC rules apply for this tournament.
20. Tournament Managers decisions are final.
