General Rules:

This is a scratch tournament open to members of Yuma USBC. Qualifying will take place during TEAM Event of the 2022 City Championships at Inca Lanes. You must enter the tournament before the first official ball is thrown. Your scratch total for that squad will determine qualifying standings. You do not have to enter on the first Team Event bowled, but you must enter in order to Re-Enter. Re-Enter as often as you are eligible, when bowling in the 2022 Yuma USBC City Championships.

The top 24 qualifying scores will bowl a 3-game qualifying squad to determine the top 8 bowlers to move on to Match Play Elimination. The top 8 bowlers will be ranked 1 thru 8 and put into bracket positions by the qualifying scores. Any ties for the final spot will be determined by a 1 game roll off. The remainder of the tournament is Double Elimination. Each bracket will bowl 2 game matches, (series winner moves on, other bowler moves to the Losers Bracket). Two losses and you're out; Last bowler is the 2022 Masters Champion. Series total will determine place in final standings. Tournament payout is determined by total entries. Final standings will be posted at the bowling center and to <http://yumausbc.org> website.

Dress code during the Masters Tournament is collared shirt and dress pants. **No Shorts or Jeans** may be worn during the Masters Tournament.

2022 Masters Champion will be presented with a plaque designating the Yuma USBC Masters Tournament Champion, First Place Prize Money, and an entry into the 2023 Yuma USBC Masters Tournament. Plaque will be presented at the Annual Awards Banquet March 26th at the American Legion Post #19.

Tournament director has the option of refunding entries and canceling the tournament if there are fewer than twenty-four entrants. Any check in payment of entry fees for the tournament, returned for non-payment, will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00. Payment must be cleared prior to bowling.
