Yuma USBC Autism Awareness 3-6-9 Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. This is a handicap tournament; handicap will be 90% of 220 and added to each bowlers four game total.
2. Divisions: Men, Women, and Youth (subdivisions boy & girl). Youth bowlers must be under 18 years of age, NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. The tournament manager will have the authority to combine divisions based on the number of entries, if done so, it will be determined and announced prior to the start of the tournament.
4. All participants must bowl in their respective divisions.
5. All bowlers must bowl four games to qualify for an award.
6. Average rule: Bowlers will use there highest 2023/2024 blue book average or 2022/2023 blue book average. If no blue book average, a current 2024/2025 league average with 12 games bowled may be used. Anyone without a bluebook or current league average will use 220.
7. The youth bowlers must be able to pick up the bowling ball off the return and carry it to the foul line. No parental or adult assistance is allowed in carrying the ball to the foul line. Please follow this rule.
8. Bumper bowlers will follow all the above guidelines.
9. Check in starts 45 minutes before the scheduled start time.
10. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the playing area.
11. Each game must be bowled on a pair of lanes.
12. Foul lights will be in operation.
13. Awards will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 5 of the final entries in each division.
14. Youth will be paid scholarships through USBC SMART account 11193.
15. Bowlers will automatically receive strikes in the 3rd, 6th, and 9th frames of each game. The total of all four games will be added together.
16. Tournament is not sanctioned by USBC but, all USBC rules apply for this tournament.
17. Tournament will be bowled in strict accordance with USBC tournament rules. Prize funds must be distributed within 30-days of close of tournament. In the case of a protest, the prizes for the position involved shall not be distributed until resolved. Any protests must be submitted in writing within 24-hours to the tournament manager.
