- 1. Tournament is open to all youth bowlers under the age of 21.
- 2. Handicap will be 90% of 180.
- 3. Bowlers will use their winter 2007/08 league average. If no winter league average, their 2008 summer league average will be used, otherwise 2006/07 average, if no average, then a scratch average will be used.
- 4. Prizes will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 4 of the final entries in each division. There will be a boys and girls sub-division for each division.

<u>PeeWee</u> <u>Bantam</u> <u>Junior</u> <u>Major</u> Ages 7 - Under Ages 8-11 Ages 12-15 Ages 16-21

Individual's age as of Aug 1, 2008, will determine age classification. The tournament manager will have the authority to combine divisions based on the amount of entries & will be decided and announced prior to the competition.

5. This No-tap tournament is sanctioned by USBC. All rules do apply. Strikes are given automatically if a 8, count is rolled on the first ball, by PeeWee & Bantam Divisions, 9 count for Junior & Major Divisions respectively.

Yuma Youth Scholarship No-tap Tournament Rules and Regulations

- 1. Divisions and rules for our tournament are stated and included.
- 2. Separate events will be held for both boys and girls in all age divisions.
- 3. Age divisions:
 - a. Peewee: 7 & under years of age
 - b. Bantams: 8-11 years of age.
 - c. Juniors: 12-15 years of age.
 - d. Majors: 16-21 years of age.
- **4.** The tournament manager will have the authority to combine divisions based on the amount of entries & will be decided prior to the competition.
- 5. Individual's age as of August 1, 2008, will determine age classification.
- 6. All participants must bowl in their own age division.
- 7. Bumper bowler's will bowl three games if able.
- 8. All other participants must bowl three games to qualify for an award.
- **9.** Average rule: Bowlers will use their winter 2007/08 league average. If no winter league average, their 2008 summer league average will be used, otherwise 2006/07 average, Bowlers with no average, or league sessions, will be classified as scratch bowlers. The Tournament Manager will add the handicap to the raw scores of the scratch bowlers using USBC guidelines.
- **10.** Peewee Division: The child must be able to pick up the bowling ball off of the rack and carry the ball to the foul line. The child can roll the ball with two hands. No parental or adult assistance is allowed in carrying the ball to the foul line. Please follow this rule.
- **11.** Bumper bowlers will follow all of the above guidelines.
- **12.** Check-in starts 30 minutes before scheduled bowling time.
- 13. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the playing area.
- 14. Coaching and refreshments are not allowed in the SETTEE area.
- 15. Each game must be bowled on a pair of lanes.
- 16. Foul lights must be in operation.
- **17.** Awards will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 4 of the final entries in each division. Scholarship Prizes will be distributed using SMART Account 11193.
- **18.** Bowlers in the PeeWee and Bantam Divisions knocking down eight pins on the first ball will be awarded a strike. Bowlers in the Junior and Major Divisions knocking down nine pins on the first ball will be awarded a strike.
- **19.** Tournament is sanctioned by USBC. Therefore, All USBC rules apply for this tournament. Any individual shooting an honor score without the aid of a no-tap strike will qualify for that award.
- 20. Tournament Managers decisions are final.
