Rules

- 1. Bowlers must use their highest Bluebook average or highest current 09-10 season average as of December 1, 2009. Adults without a current league or book average shall use 210 as there average. Youth without a current league or book average shall enter with a 180 average. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction may disqualify your score, if submitted average is lower than actual average; prizes will be based on submitted average if it is higher.
- 2. Handicap will be calculated at 90% of 420 for all teams.
- 3. Bowlers must check in 15 minutes before scheduled squad time.
- 4. Prize fees will be returned 100%. In case of ties, prizes will be split.
- 5. Scholarship fees will be returned 100% in each division at a ratio of 1to 4.
- 6. A bowler may enter *The Forty Frame Game, Doubles Fundraiser for the Humane Society of Yuma* as often as he/she wishes as long as the doubles partner is different from a partner he/she has already bowled with. Same Partners may cash only once!
- 7. Scores will be recorded by a tournament official. Bowlers will certify their scores as being correct at the completion of the game by signing their score sheet. This will be the only time to correct any scoring errors.
- 8. In the 40th frame, if you do not *Bingo* (1st ball strike), you do not get a chance to *Bango* (2nd ball strike). If you don't *Bango*, you do not get a chance to *Bongo* (3rd ball strike).
- 9. The 1st bowler will bowl the 1st frame and alternate frames with the 2nd bowler; The 2nd bowler will bowl the 2nd frame and every even frame thereafter for the first 20 frames, then bowl the 21<sup>st</sup> frame and odd frames thereafter.
- 10. Youth bowlers may not be paid in cash for any prizes.
- 11. Prizes will be distributed within 30 days of completion of tournament.
- 12. Entries close 5 December, 2009 (15 minutes prior to last squad.)
- 13. Entry fee is \$30 per team (\$15 per bowler).
- 14. Make checks payable to Yuma USBC.
- 15. Tournament will be held at Wild River Family Entertainment Center.
- 16. Youth Scholarships paid through SMART account 11193.
- 17. Scholarships awarded on a ratio of 1 to 4 entries.
- 18. Divisions will not be combined if minimum number of entries not received.
