1. Tournament is open to all youth bowlers under the age of 21.
2. Handicap will be 90% of 180.
3. Bowlers will use their current 2008/09 league average. If no current league average, their 2008 summer league average will be used, otherwise 2007/08 average, if no average, bowler must use 180 average.
4. Prizes will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 4 of the final entries in each division. There will be a boys and girls sub-division for each division.

Yuma Youth Halloween 3,6,9 Scholarship Tournament Rules

1. Divisions and rules for our tournament are stated and included.
2. Separate events will be held for both boys and girls in all age divisions.
3. Age divisions:
 - a. *Peewee: Minimum age is 3. Maximum age is 7.*
 - b. *Bantams: 8-11 years of age.*
 - c. *Juniors: 12-15 years of age.*
 - d. *Majors: 16-21 years of age.*
4. Individual's age as of October 1, 2008, will determine age classification.
5. All participants must bowl in their own age division.
6. Bumper bowler's must bowl three games.
7. All participants must bowl three games to qualify for an award.
8. Average rule: Bowlers will use their current 2008/09 league average. If no current league average, their 2008 summer league average will be used, otherwise 2007/08 average, Bowlers with no average, or league sessions, will be classified as scratch bowlers. The Tournament Manager will add the handicap to the raw scores of the scratch bowlers using USBC guidelines.
9. The tournament manager will have the authority to combine divisions based on the amount of entries & will be decided prior to the competition.
10. Peewee Division: The child must be able to pick up the bowling ball off of the rack and carry the ball to the foul line. The child can roll the ball with two hands, with or without bumpers. No parental or adult assistance is allowed in carrying the ball to the foul line. Please follow this rule.
11. Bumper bowlers will follow all of the above guidelines.
12. Check-in starts 40 minutes before scheduled bowling time.
13. Costumes: Suitable attire must be worn, must be safe for bowling.
14. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the playing area.
15. Coaching and refreshments are not allowed in the SETTEE area.
16. Each game must be bowled on a pair of lanes.
17. Foul lights must be in operation.
18. Awards will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 4 of the final entries in each division. Scholarship Prizes will be distributed using SMART account 11193.
19. Costume contest will be judged by coaches, results are final.
20. Bowling Pin decorating contest will be judged by coaches and Tournament Officials, results are final.
21. Tournament is not sanctioned but, All USBC rules apply for this tournament.
22. Tournament Managers decisions are final.
