1. Tournament is open to League and Non-League bowlers of all ages.
2. Handicap will be 90% of 200 for league bowlers.
3. Bowlers will use their 2007-2008 blue book average or must have a minimum of 21 games bowled in current 08/09 league. If no current average, their 2008 summer league average will be used, and if no summer average, a scratch average will be as follows: Youth 150, Women 185, and Men 200.
4. Prize ratio is 1 in 5 of the divisions final entries.
5. 9 pins knocked down on the first ball will be awarded a strike.

Susan G. Komen No-tap Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Divisions and rules for our tournament are stated and included.
2. Divisions for each event:

<u>Youth</u>	<u>Women</u>	<u>Men</u>
Div 1 – 150 & Over	Div 1 – 165 & Over	Div 1 – 191 & Over
Div 2 – 100 to 149	Div 2 – 125 to 164	Div 2 – 160 to 190
Div 3 – 99 & Under	Div 3 – 124 & Under	Div 3 – 159 & Under

3. The tournament manager will have the authority to combine divisions based on the amount of entries & will be decided prior to the competition.
4. Average rule: Bowlers will use their highest 07/08 Blue Book Average. If no Blue Book Average then the current 2008/09 league average will be used. If no current league average, their 2008 summer league average will be used, otherwise will bowl scratch. A scratch average will be as follows: Youth 150, Women 185, and Men 200.
5. Handicap is 90% of 200
6. Awards will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 5 of the final entries in each division.
7. Youth bowlers will be awarded in Scholarship prizes.
8. Scholarship Prizes will be distributed using SMART Account 11193.
9. Bowlers knocking down nine pins on the first ball will be awarded a strike.
10. Foul lights must be in operation.
11. Each game must be bowled on a pair of lanes.
12. Check-in starts 45 minutes before scheduled bowling time.
13. Tournament is sanctioned by USBC. Therefore, All USBC rules apply for this tournament. Any Sanctioned bowler shooting an honor score without the aid of a no-tap strike will qualify for that award.
14. Non-League bowlers may elect to purchase a USBC Sanction card prior to the Tournament in order to qualify for USBC Awards.
15. 50/50 raffles during each squad will benefit the Susan G. Komen Bowl for the Cure.
16. Tournament Manager decisions are final.
