## YUMA USBC – 10<sup>th</sup> - ANNUAL SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament open to all USBC sanctioned bowlers who are members of the Yuma USBC prior to participation in the tournament and are 55 years of age as of January 25, 2009.
2. The following limits shall apply to current, active members of any organization of professional bowlers as of 01 August 2008 : (a) Each such bowler shall be eligible to enter singles and all events; (b) but not more than two (2) such bowlers on a four man team line-up; (c) nor more than one such bowler in a two man line-up.
3. "Protests ": The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
4. Handicap shall be based on eighty (80) per cent of the difference between the entrant's average and 220 for Singles; 440 for Doubles; 880 for Team. All Events will be based on the Singles Event handicap times three. There will be no minus handicap.
5. USBC Chevrons and trophies will be awarded to the highest total of actual pinfall and handicap in each event. In the case of a tie, co-champions shall be declared and duplicate awards will be given.
6. Cash prizes will be awarded for each event on a handicap basis.
7. Prize fees shall be returned in Ratio of a minimum 1 to 6 for the team, doubles & singles events and a minimum of 1 to 20 in all events.
8. Any check in payment for the entry fees for this tournament that is returned for non-payment will be assessed a service charge of \$20.00.
9. Dress Code Rule: All participants shall wear a shirt with a butterfly type "collar" with sleeves and full-length dress trousers or Jeans will be allowed as long as they have no holes. The following apparel is not permitted while participating in this Yuma USBC Tournament: Tank top shirts, shorts, cut-offs, hats or caps, sweats, skirts, skorts, coulottes, zuba, spandex and Capri pants. Failure to comply, bowler will not be allowed to bowl and cause forfeiture of entry fees.
10. USBC Membership cards, or proof of purchase, must be presented in order to bowl. No cards sold at tournament site.
11. Participants initial competition in the doubles/singles event requires them to bowl both doubles and singles. With multiple participation allowed in doubles, the participant only pays for and bowls the doubles portion after the initial competition. Doubles will be bowled first. Maximum of two (2) doubles teams per pair of lanes.
12. Any change(s) to the order of the original bowling lineup submitted, shall be requested, at least 30 minutes prior to time scheduled to bowl.
13. Multiple participation by a bowler is allowed but limited to once per each team and doubles event squad. Multiple participants in doubles must bowl both the doubles and singles events the first time they bowl in these events.
14. Under this tournament's multiple participation format, the bowler's first appearance in each event counts towards their all events scratch and handicap totals.
15. With multiple participation permitted, the following provisions apply in order to place more than once in the prize list for position standings:
  - (a) four man team event – at least two players in the lineup must be different.; and,
  - (b) doubles event – at least one player in the lineup must be different.
16. Entering Averages -
  1. Entrants will use their highest winter average listed in 2007-2008 YBA / YWBA bluebook based upon a minimum of 21 games.
  2. If no winter average in these bluebooks, entrant will use their highest current Yuma USBC winter average of 21 games or more as of January 01, 2009.
  3. If an entrant does not have a winter average for a minimum of 21 games, in a league sanctioned by the Yuma USBC, in either the current or past winter season, the tournament management will accept the entrant's highest summer average in 2007-2008 Yuma USBC bluebook for a minimum of 21 games.
  4. An entrant having no acceptable established average under this tournament's rules shall bowl scratch. Entrant will be assigned a 220 average.
  5. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average as submitted by, either the bowler, their team captain, or others. Failure to use the correct average shall result in disqualification if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average.
  6. Average corrections can be made up to the end of the bowler's first game of a series. Or, if an extension of time has been granted in writing by tournament management before the end of the first game of a series, then the correct average must be submitted within 48 hours after the end of the series.
  7. "Ten Pin Rule": USBC Rule 319 (a . 2) does not apply.
  8. "Reporting Prize Winnings": USBC Rule 319 (d) does not apply. Entrant does not have to report previous winnings.
  9. "Tournament Average": USBC Rule 319(e) does not apply.
17. If not specifically covered in the Yuma USBC Association tournament rules, then the USBC Tournament Rules shall apply.
