1. All entrants must be members of YUMA USBC
2. The tournament shall be handicap and the Championship scratch, by division 1, 2, and 3. It shall consist of a four woman team event, doubles event and singles event. All events shall be optional. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in each event and total pins shall decide the winner. The total of 9 games bowled shall determine the all events winner in each division.
3. Entrant shall use her highest league average, as of the end of the 07-08 winter season, provided she has bowled 21 games. If no book average, then the following averages shall be used in order listed. Averages must be established in Yuma USBC WBA.
 - A. Highest 07-08 summer league average of 21 games or more.
 - B. Highest current league average for 08-09 season of 21 games or more as of 12/27/08 in Yuma USBC.
 - D. If no Yuma USBC WBA or Yuma USBC average, entrant must use 200 as their entering average. Non-members may purchase an affiliate card. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series.
4. Handicap shall be 80% of 200.
5. An entrant may participate in team event 4 times, however not more than 2 players may bowl more than twice in team event and may place in prize list each time. A bowler entering doubles the first time shall bowl singles and vice versa. An entrant may participate in doubles 2 times. 2nd entry must be with a different bowler. Participants may only bowl singles and all events once. All events shall be paid in the field.
6. Three sets of doubles will be scheduled to a pair of lanes. When it is not possible, two complete sets will be scheduled to a pair.
7. When a bowler participates more than once in team events or doubles, her first appearance in each shall count towards her all events. All events is 1st scores bowled in team, doubles and singles.
8. Subs are allowed. The tournament secretary must be advised of all subs at least one hour before the scheduled bowling time if possible. In case of an emergency, after a game has started, a sub, if one is available shall be allowed in team and doubles only. The combined scores are to count in either of these events. If no sub is available, only the actual number of frames bowled shall count. A sub, when replacing another bowler, must bowl the team/doubles/singles for the same bowler in order to qualify for all events, provided the all events is paid. A sub shall not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee or prize money or award she may win.
9. No pacers will be permitted.
10. There shall be no changes made in the lineup or disqualification may result.
11. Any player arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl but the frames missed will

be given a zero.

12. Disorderly conduct will be cause for disqualification.

13. Singles shall be bowled immediately following doubles. If a bowler is late for doubles, her partner will bowl her singles first. If her partner has not arrived by the time the event is finished and a sub is not available, she will be allowed to bowl her doubles event to qualify for her all events. A player arriving late will receive a zero for each frame missed.

14. When players are scheduled without opposition she must bowl as though she is actually contested. Entrant must complete her frame on one lane before the player bowling lead off can start her next frame on the adjoining lane.

15. In case of a tie for championship in any event, a co-championship shall be declared and duplicate awards given. If a tie occurs in the field (handicap) in any event the prize money shall be combined and divided equally.

16. Any protest on rules or eligibility must be submitted in writing prior to disbursement of prize money. Errors in scoring must be reported within 24 hours to the tournament director. Yuma USBC will have the power to act on all protests.

17. All cash prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis in the field. All prize fees collected in an event or division of an event will be returned 100% in that event or division of that event.

18. Beverages will be permitted back of the bowling area. No one but participants will be allowed in the bowling area.

19. Hand powder packs may be used but must be kept out of the playing area. Defacing the approaches will be strictly enforced.

20. Prize funds must be distributed within 30 days of close of tournament. In the case of a protest, the prizes for the position involved shall not be distributed until resolved.

21. USBC Rule 319e "15 or more pin increase in average" is waived. 10 or more pin increase in average need not be reported.

USBC Rule 319d "reporting prior prize winnings of cash/merchandise of \$600.00 or more in any tournament" is waived.
